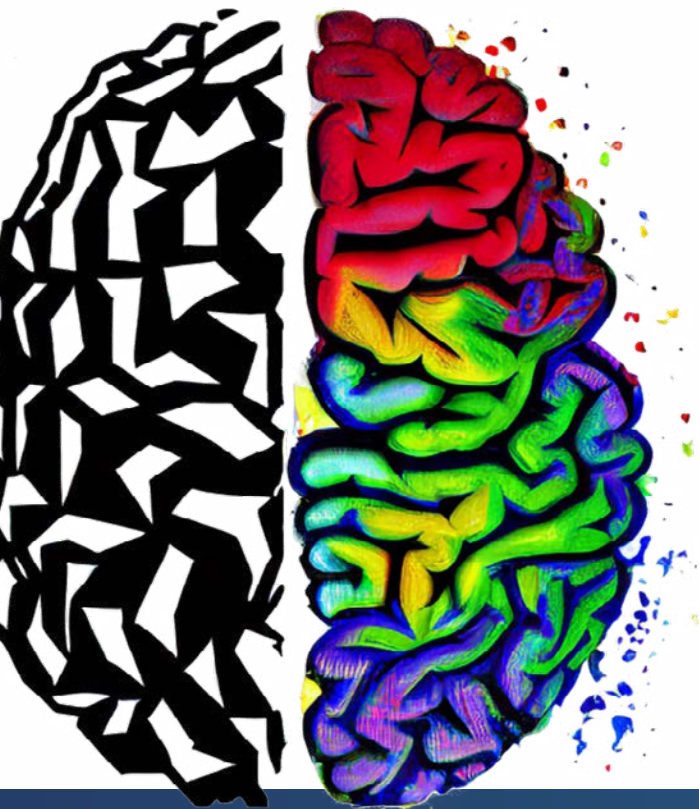
JANUARY 11, 2024
