



Abstracts Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

The following questions address common topics related to abstract submission, poster presentations, registration, and e-poster requirements for the ASPNR 2027 Annual Meeting.

Submitted Abstracts

Q. Can I submit more than one abstract?

A. *Yes. Each submitter may submit up to three (3) abstracts.*

Q. Can I update my abstract after it has been submitted?

A. *Yes. You may edit your abstract submission at any time until the abstract submission deadline of **September 18, 2026**, at **11:59 PM ET**. After this deadline, no additional revisions or new abstract submissions will be accepted.*

Q. When will I be notified if my abstract has been accepted for the ASPNR 2027 Annual Meeting?

A. *Abstract acceptance notifications will be emailed to the submitting author in late **October 2026**. Notifications are sent only to the submitting author and not to all co-authors. It is the responsibility of the submitting author to notify all co-authors of the acceptance decision and any presentation details.*

Accepted Abstracts

Q. Do I have to register to present my poster?

A. *Yes. Presenting authors must register for the Annual Meeting by **January 4, 2027** to remain eligible to present their poster.*

Q. What happens if I miss the December 18, 2026 award deadline?

A. You may still present your poster at the Annual Meeting if all other requirements are met; however, your poster will not be eligible for award consideration.

Q. What file format should I upload my E-Poster?

A. All e-posters must be uploaded as PDF files through the Poster Presenter Portal.

Q. Why do I need to submit two versions of my E-Poster?

A. One version is a redacted Award Review E-Poster used for the blinded award review process. The second version is the Annual Meeting E-Poster, which is displayed in the ASPNR Mobile App for meeting attendees.

Q. Can I update my E-Poster after uploading it?

A. Yes. Updates are permitted until the final upload deadline of January 4, 2027. After this date, no additional revisions will be accepted.

Q. Can someone else present my poster?

A. Yes. If you are unable to attend the Annual Meeting, another author may present your poster on your behalf, provided they are a registered attendee. Once you know you are unable to attend and have identified the alternate presenter, please notify ASPNR as soon as possible so we can update our records.
